The term zombie may have drifted into the world from the word "nzambi" that came from the lower Congo River area of Africa, a sign that calls forth an "invisible being from the terrible earth", with the potential to take possession of a body that then becomes a "nzambi" drone. In the 21st century zombies have become the sign of all things post-human: from undead media to zombie capitalism(s); from Fox News' zombies to Obama zombies; as a perfect dead-form for immaterial labor, to the material formations of rebellions against command and control society; from a nzambi style virus, to preying nanites, to an un/godly zone too full to be contained. We are now living in global zombie zone where the dead are switched on and life is turned off. Everywhere inhuman rage becomes the contagion of speeding viroids or the (un)human shambling swarms of inertia returning as the living dead seeking brains to kill the pain or just plain "bare life" burning in plies off in the distance. Zombies are more us than we are: they are our evolutionary horizon, our devolutionary past, and our present aesthetics of involution. So let's make some "nzambi" gestures and consider our post-contemporary state(s) of dis/possession arising from the terrible earth(s) right beneath our feet.
